CALL TO ACTION! LEGISLATIVE UPDATE FROM LACEY MILLER

Hello Washington AWHONN members! AWHONN needs your support to endorse **The Black Maternal Health Omnibus Act of 2020**. Our goal is to meet with Congress members throughout Washington State on behalf of AWHONN.

What is it?

The Act combines nine individual bills sponsored by members of the bipartisan Black Maternal Health Caucus.

What will it do?

It promises to prevent maternal death and severe pregnancy complications and diminish maternal and neonatal health disparities.

How will it do this? The Act will...

Offer grants for bias training given to professionals who interact with pregnant and postpartum women.

Make critical investments in social determinants of health that influence maternal health outcomes, like housing, transportation, and nutrition.

Provide funding to community-based organizations working to improve maternal health outcomes for Black women.

The AWHONN Educational Advisory Committee (EAC) consists of 21 members that guide development of educational products and services for the 350,000 working in our specialty and support the engagement and development of nurse educators (AWHONN, 2020). This dynamic group meets virtually once a month to strategize and brainstorm. Following a meeting, members spend several weeks preparing to deliver feedback and solutions at the next month's collaboration.

I have been a member of this committee since January 2020. One of the projects I have worked on was the creation of infographics for AWHONN's *Back to Basics: Foundations of Mindful Care*, created to encourage nurses to go "back to the basics" of what we do. It has been a privilege to work on the maternal immunization task force over the past 2 years. AWHONN completed several big projects this year including 2 short 60 second explainer videos. The content of the videos was based on results of a survey aimed to identify our nurse's knowledge, beliefs and practices on immunization. In addition, we created 3 vaccination education infographic resources and built a page on AWHONN's website where the videos, call to action and helpful immunization resources are easily found.

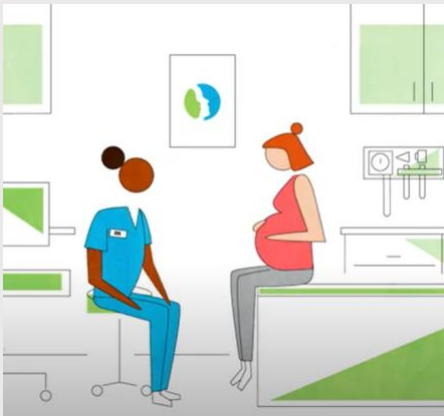

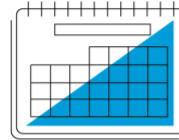
Tdap video



Tdap Vaccine



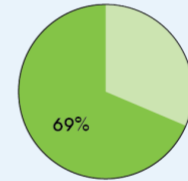
Quick Facts
